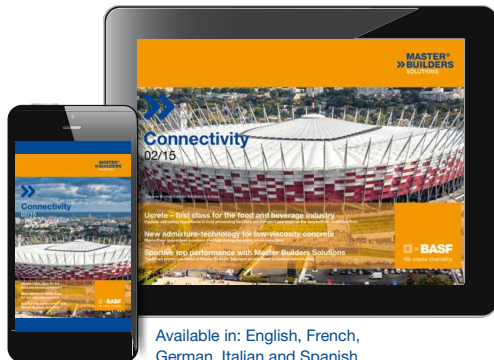

Opening of new Master Builders Solutions Training Center in Oidenburg, Germany

Functional and creative car park in Aarhus, Denmark

As an integral part of the exciting new Nielsen building in Aarhus, Denmark, a 2600 m² underground car park was established. The greatest challenge faced by engineers was a concrete substrate that was cracked and the need for a resilient, alkali floor coating that was durable and could withstand the day-to-day traffic of a busy car park. To achieve this result, the cracks in the concrete substrate were repaired using MasterSeal 1325 and MasterSeal 1360 injection resin.

Subsequently, MasterSeal Traffic 2200, a robust epoxy resin system for ramps and intermediate decks, was applied to the surface. MasterSeal Traffic 2200 is a highly durable surface that can withstand heavy traffic and is resistant to wetting, road salt, and motor oil and fuel.

Expanding Austria's Pyhrn motorway

MasterGemsium SKY and MasterKor concrete admixtures facilitate the smooth progression of the expansion work.

The 232 km long Pyhrn motorway is one of the Eastern Alpine main north-south traffic arteries connecting Upper Austria with Slovenia via Graz, Austria's second largest city. Key milestones of the expansion include the construction of a second tube for the 5.8 km Birkbach tunnel and the recent expansion of the River bridge. Enabling smooth and, most importantly, speedy concrete placement, the concrete admixtures from Master Builders Solutions have made vital contributions to the successful realisation of both projects.
